



ORDER

Commissioner Industries, Government of Rajasthan has informed vide letter No. F.33()CI/EODB/2017 dated 11.10.2017 that a Central Inspection System(CIS) has been institutionalized in reference to BRAP-2017 reform point Nos. 86, 87 and 88, for streamlining the inspections of Labour, Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board and Factories & Boilers Inspection Department.

It was also informed that Central Inspection System has been developed by DoIT&C on Single Window System portal <http://swcs.rajasthan.gov.in> to integrate the departmental inspection system with CIS for synchronization of inspections and implementation of criteria described in Implementation Guide of BRAP-2017 for above reform points.

It is hereby directed that following action points, to implement Central Inspection System, should be followed-

- a. All compliance inspections pertaining to Factories & Boilers shall be generated through Centralized Inspection System.
- b. The inspections shall be conducted in synchronization with Labour and/ or Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board departments wherever jointly scheduled in Central Inspection system.
- c. The scheduling of inspections will be done through automated randomized manner based on computerized risk assessment by the online system.
- d. The computerized risk assessment will be done as per the risk assessment logic of the participating departments.
- e. Submit the inspection report online within 48 hours on the CIS.
- f. Ensure same inspector cannot perform two consecutive inspections of the same business.
- g. Surprise inspections to be done based on complaints with specific permission from Head of Department
